What is Asbestos?

Asbestos is a naturally occuring mineral found in trace amounts throughout the world. Asbestos fibres are microscopic in nature which makes them difficult to detect with the naked eye. It has also been classified as a human carcinogen, a substance that causes cancer.

Asbestos is recognized for being fire retardant, extremely durable and resistant to chemical erosion. These properties made it a popular building material between 1950 and 1990. It can often be found in building materials such as, roofing shingles, floor tiles, ceiling materials, cement products and drywall.

Asbestos and Drywall

Until 1990, the tape and joint compound, or mud, used to seal the seams and fill gaps between drywall boards may have contained asbestos. Since the mud is feathered to cover large areas with a smooth finish, the entire piece of drywall must be treated as containing asbestos.

UNDERSTANDING THE **REGULATIONS**

WorkSafeBC regulates that any material containing more than 0.5% by content of asbestos fibres is a hazardous material. This material should be handled by certified professionals as the asbestos fibres can be very dangerous.

At the end of 2015, WorkSafeBC introduced new regulations affecting the acceptance of drywall at Waste Transfer Stations. Drywall can no longer be accepted unless it has the proper date stamp or it has been tested for asbestos.

For asbestos-containing materials over 1,000kg a Hazardous Waste Generator (BCG) needs to be registered. This process can be complicated so our staff members can assist you with the application process.
